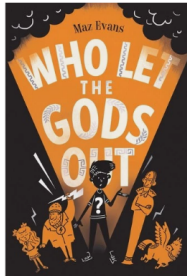

<u>Literacy</u>	<u>Maths</u>
Reading - "Who Let the Gods Out?" by Maz Evans is our first reading book of the summer term, which will help develop our reading comprehension skills. Writing - we will firstly be focussing on 3rd person narrative writing as our fictional piece. We will also learn about discursive writing including the specific vocabulary associated with the genre as well as identifying points of view from both sides of an argument. The Year 6 children will also be preparing for their SATs in Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG) and Reading. 	In Maths we will be covering the following topics: - Fractions, decimals and percentages - calculating amounts of each and converting between. - Algebra - using formulae and number machines. - Shape - identifying and calculating angles, investigating circles and drawing 3D shapes. - Statistics - interpreting different graphs and ways of holding information. We will also continue to practice our mental agility with maths and develop our knowledge of maths facts. The Year 6 children will be practicing SAT style questions through our SAT Busters.
