King Raedwald will be giving class 2 a special mission this term – below are some of the things we are going to be learning about in order to complete the task!

In **LITERACY** we will be writing non-chronological reports and Anglo-Saxon myths. We will learn grammar alongside this, practice handwriting regularly and have guided reading twice a week.

Year 2 and some members of Year 3 will also have daily phonics.

In **MATHS** we will be continuing our work on multiplication; learning to tell the time and learn about basic fractions (Years 3 and 4, decimals too).

In **SCIENCE** we will be learning about states of matter, the water cycle and sound. March sees the return of National Science week – please keep an eye out for more information nearer the time.

Our **TOPIC** this term will have a strong history emphasis, focusing on the Anglo Saxons. The Sutton Hoo artefacts are coming to school at the end of January and we will be learning all about the Saxon way of life. We will be working with clay in **ART** to recreate some Anglo Saxon pieces and will be using our **D&T** skills to build moving boats!



In **MUSIC** we are going to start learning about different notes and the early stages of how to read music by learning the recorder. If your child would like to bring their own in, they may do so in a named case.

In **RE** we will be learning about how Muslims show Allah is compassionate and merciful and how Christians use symbols to represent Jesus and his resurrection.

PE will still be delivered on a Wednesday afternoon by inspire sport, where children will be playing various invasion games and Friday afternoons by me where we will be working on our gymnastics and cross country.

FRENCH will still be taught by Mrs Wells on a weekly basis. This term's topic is 'Quel temps fait-il?' - all about the weather.

In **COMPUTING** we will be perfecting our word processing skills and learning how to create PowerPoint presentations.
